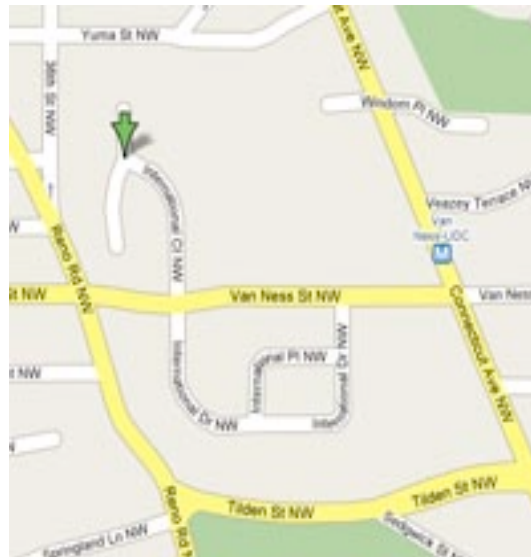


Directions to the Office of Science & Technology at the Embassy of Austria in Washington, D.C. 3524 International Court, N.W.

The Embassy of Austria is located about 5.9 mi (9.5 km) northwest of Washington, DC's center and can be reached conveniently by car or by Metro:



by Car:

Coming from the north or the south, the embassy may best be reached via **Wisconsin Avenue** or **Connecticut Avenue**. From there, turn onto **Van Ness Street** and go straight until **International Drive** (with a small green sign saying "Austrian Chancery").

- Coming from **Connecticut Avenue**, International Drive is the first street on the right
- Coming from **Wisconsin Avenue**, International Drive is the first street on the left after Reno Road

Follow the long curve all the way and then take another right onto **International Court**. Limited Visitor's Parking is provided at the embassy. For further information on driving directions, please visit <http://www.mapquest.com>.

by Metro:

The nearest Metro Stop **VAN NESS-UDC** (Red Line, Exit Van Ness UDC) on Connecticut Avenue is about a 6-minute walk from the Austrian Embassy. Walk down **Connecticut Avenue** heading south, passing the **University of the District of Columbia** (UDC). Make a right onto **Van Ness Street** and go up the hill until **International Drive** on the right. Walk around the bend on International Drive, turn right into the cul-de-sac, which is International Court. The Austrian Embassy is at the very end on the left.
