



## Curriculum vitae - Dr. Andrea KDOLSKY

Within the Austrian Federal Government Dr. Andrea Kdolsky is responsible for health, family and youth. From March 2006 until the time she took office, the 45-year-old specialist physician for anaesthesiology and intensive-care medicine was the medical managing director of the Lower Austrian Federal Hospital Holding (NÖ Landeskliniken-Holding).

Andrea Kdolsky was born in Vienna on November 2, 1962. After graduating from a Catholic secondary school, she studied law at Vienna University and commerce at Vienna University of Economics and Business Administration and worked in the private sector. As a "late starter", she commenced her medical studies at Vienna University in 1986 and graduated in 1993. After that, she completed a training course for health-care management and economics at Vienna University of Economics and Business Administration and for Process-Oriented Quality Management at WIFI Vienna.

Following her intern doctor traineeship at the Eggenburg hospital (1995), Ms Kdolsky started her training to become a specialist physician for anaesthesiology, intensive-care medicine and pain therapy at the medical school of the AKH, which she completed in 2001. From 2001 to 2004 she was a senior physician at the University Hospital for Anaesthesiology, Intensive-Care Medicine and Pain Therapy. Following a brief period as deputy general manager of the Federal Institute for International Education and Technology Transfer (BIB), Ms Kdolsky moved in 2005 to NÖ Landeskliniken-Holding, where in March 2006 she became medical managing director.
